## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Western Province Sport Parachute Club (WPSPC) is located just outside of Robertson in the Western Cape, approximately 150km from Cape Town on major roads. Robertson is a thriving tourist town in a wine-producing region along the famous Route 62. Accommodation, entertainment and good food are readily available both in town, which is directly adjacent to the airfield and on surrounding wine farms. Accommodation options range from luxurious wine and game farms to economical backpackers.

Landing areas include a mowed area on the windline beyond the runway for A and B licensed jumpers, and a smaller mowed grass landing area adjacent to the clubhouse for C and D licensed jumpers. Shaded creeping areas will be provided within a hangar with sufficient space for up to 8-way. A zap wagon will be available on the DZ to collect competitors from out landings. Shade will be provided at boarding point.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

Accommodation is available within walking distance of the drop zone and throughout the town. WPSPC has a list of recommended facilities who will give preferential rates to skydivers (see Appendix I). These include B&Bs and Backpackers. If desired, information on more upmarket options on wine farms can be sourced from the Robertson Tourism bureau.

Camping facilities are available reasonably close to Robertson but are popular around Easter. Bookings should be made as soon as possible. A group option is being looked into close to the DZ depending on interest.

#### **RESTAURANTS**

The canteen will serve breakfast, lunch and snacks daily. Suppers will be able to be ordered. Details will be placed on the noticeboard inside the canteen area. There will be a licensed bar in the spectator area from 5pm until 10pm daily. This excludes Easter Sunday although if a license can be obtained for that date this may change.

There is a wide choice of restaurants within Robertson. These include local businesses, restaurant chains and fast food franchises. There are first class restaurants on wine farms around the town. For self-catering, there is an excellent Spar as well as several other supermarkets.

# FRIENDS AND FAMILY

Skydive Robertson is generally a pet and child-friendly dropzone. However it has been decided that for safety reasons no pets will be allowed on the dropzone during the competition. Children under 10 will be limited to the spectator areas during the competition.

#### REGISTRATION AND COSTS TO COMPETITORS

All registrations must be submitted by Friday the 1st of April 2011 to qualify for the standard registration fee and welcome pack. Late registration will be accepted until the 23<sup>rd</sup> of April 2011 for Atmonauti and until the 24<sup>th</sup> of April for FS and AE, with a penalty fee of R200 applying in either case.

### Registration

Registration will be R 1,100.00 per person competing regardless of the number of events. This will include a minimal welcome pack and the Nationals Awards Ceremony and braai which will take place on the airfield.

Registration will be done on a team basis and will include all the competition jumps. This fee must be paid no later than Friday 1 April to avoid late-registration penalties.

If an individual or team withdraws from the championship after official registration, they will forfeit an amount of R500 per person. The balance will be repaid within 15 days following the end of the competition. Any team or individual who is grounded for safety or other reasons, will forfeit the full registration fee.

SSA membership is a requirement for participation in the National Championships. Participants not complying with this requirement will be disqualified.

## Jump Rates and Altitudes

The slot rate for all competition altitudes will be R240. These rates are subject to change without notice.

## **CONDUCTING THE COMPETITION**

## **Dates**

The proposed dates for and around the competition are as follows

The decision to host Atmonauti on the 24<sup>th</sup> was taken because many of these competitors will wish to participate in the other events as competitors or cameramen. Should bad weather be a factor it will be decided in conjunction with the judges whether to reschedule or to cut the event short.

#### **Manifest**

Manifest will take place from the Container at the rear of the Club Hangar. Notice boards will be used to keep competitors updated with information such as manifest schedules and scores. Manifest calls will start with a 45 minute call, and continue with 30 minutes, 15 minutes (walk out to boarding point) and last call. Calls will be made using a PA system.

Premanifest will be available for the training days. Please email <a href="mailto:nationals@skydive.co.za">nationals@skydive.co.za</a> to premanifest, indicating which teams will be training and how many jumps they require per day.

#### Aircraft

The PAC 750 XL which is type certified for skydiving will be utilized. There are currently no airspace restrictions at Robertson. Elevation is approximately 600ft AMSL

# Aircraft Oxygen

No oxygen will be provided. Competitors may bring their own aviation oxygen on board provided it complies with CAA safety standards. No medical oxygen will be allowed on board.

## **Competition Rules**

The FAI sporting code and the competition rules for each discipline are available on the PASA website (www.para.co.za).

# SSA Membership and Fees

All participants are required to be fully paid up members of both the Parachute Association of South Africa and the Sport Skydivers' Association at the commencement of the competition. Participants not complying with this requirement will be disqualified.

Visiting International jumpers who have paid for temporary PASA membership may participate in the event without SSA membership as guest entries, but will be ineligible for placing or medals.

#### Re-jumps

The cost for re-jumps awarded in accordance with discipline / event rules are for the account of the competitor. Re-jumps due to failure in event organization are for the account of the organizer.

#### Medals / Awards Ceremony

This will take place at the airfield, at 7pm, on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> April. It will be followed by a braai with live music and a DJ.
