Jump Accounts:

All jumps for all rounds of registered events must be paid in full 1 week prior to the start of the competition, including your portion of the videographer's slots. Our manifest lead commits to having reconciliations and statements completed by no later than 17:00 on Friday 10 April 2026. Our finance officer commits to having any refunds processed in full by no later than 30 April 2026, provided all necessary documents have been provided timeously.

Re-jumps:

Re-jumps awarded in accordance with the rules will be for the account of the competitor.

Re-jumps due to judging equipment failure or event organisation faults are for the account of the organiser.

Medical Aid:

As per the SSA mandate, all competitors will be required to be on a Medical Aid and furnish the organisers with these details during the registration process.

PASA and SSA Memberships

All competitors must be fully paid-up members of both the Parachute Association of South Africa (PASA) and the Sport Skydivers Association (SSA) at the start of the competition.

Competitors who do not meet this requirement will not be permitted to compete.

Jumpers holding a temporary PASA membership may participate as Guest Competitors.

Guest Competitors are not eligible for medals, rankings or national titles, but their results will be published for record-keeping purposes.

Calls will be made over a PA system, audible from the packing, creeping and competitor hangar.

Disciplines will be manifested in time blocks as much as possible in order to allow competitors to compete in more than one event within a discipline.

Preference will be given to FAI events.

In the event of weather, aircraft or unforeseen delays, scheduled times may change to accommodate FAI events.

Manifest will be published and available at the dropzone on live screens to keep competitors informed, but competitors are to make themselves available per FAI competition rules, should the need arise to adjust jump times.

Manifest will accommodate competitors entered into multiple events as far as possible, however no competition will be held back due competitors competing in multiple events. Competitors may be required to prioritise certain events so as not to disrupt the competition.

Notice Boards:

Notice boards and a dedicated competitors' WhatsApp group will be used to inform competitors of briefing times, updates or other important notifications.

ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT

On-Site Camping:

2 person dome tents with stretchers and bedding will be available on location at a flat rate of R2 200 per tent from Friday 27 March 2026 to Friday 3 April 2026, bookable through the organisers.
